Negronita

Gin, Narendrajji insisted, is best reserved for the newly initiated or for breakfast's earliest clink. For all other hours, the spirit ought to honour the plant that birthed it.

And so, we shake up pure agave with bitters and our house-made Vermouth, yielding a crisp, floral, ever-so-slightly bitter sip perfectly suited to any hour one deems worthy.

Espresso Martini

Just when we fancied that coffee hour had reached the peak of civility, we chanced upon an old, whisper-soft recipe for an Espresso Martini. And just as we were basking in that newfound bliss, along came a revelation: a gentle flicker of fresh orange was the missing note in the drink and in our lives.

Welcome Rose

Welcoming guests with a shower of roses was, of course, de rigueur at the Haveli. Yet even amidst the fragrance and fanfare, our gracious host found himself feeling rather...parched by all the ceremony.

So, with a knowing smile, he returned to a forgotten cabinet. one lined with dusty glass and whispered lineage and unearthed a beautifully preserved royal rose liqueur.

And thus, the tradition evolved: the same lavish welcome, now delivered with a little more spirit, quite literally.

Bikaner Tea Party

To question the norms can sometimes be a celebration of reasoning. When told that whiskey was only ideal for evenings, Narendra Singh ji decided to host a brunch and served pitchers of his favourite pick-me-up: a fizzy, fruity iced tea...with a generous shot of Bourbon!

Maybe he left out that last ingredient when telling everyone but, as people staggered home the next morning, nobody seemed to have minded the spiked infusion.

Crème Brûlée Sour

So this one time the Doctor's orders were firm - refrain from tippling or else skip the dessert. Narendra Singh ji was anything if not disciplined. But he was also quite creative, finding a way to skip both, yet neither!

Tiger Lily

Does power always have to be intimidating? Not really, as is demonstrated in this gin and ginger meets passion fruit number. It's gentle yet distinct, fluid yet structured. We deign to label it a daytime drink because such constructs only serve to confine the imbibers' imagination.

Fresh Watermelon Margarita

Margaritas are a great example of textbook mixology, which is what made it all the more boring to Narendraji and once, when his guests challenged him to make something better, he opened up not only the closet but also the cold pantry and a few slices and dices later, this drink emerged.

Jamun

The world is waking up to the Picante only now but here at the Bhawan, we had always prescribed a recipe when the jamun was still young for the season and extremely tart; spice was a great way to reign it in. And who has ever complained about a shot of Tequila to liven things up?

Gulkand Nightcap

The idea of a nightcap was quite alien to Thakurji and the first time he received an invitation to one, he suspected foul play, or worse yet, a disguised signal for licentiousness. Nevertheless, he complied and returned, as he put it, 'extremely gratified'.

We don't know what transpired but, going forth, at the end of his fabulous feasts, he started serving people this creamy concoction instead of the traditional 'paan'.

Barrel-Aged Negroni / Sazerac

This symbiosis was started at the Bhawan one year when the barrels ran dry. We immediately irrigated the insides with two traditional mixes which would benefit from some time under oak while also ensuring that the heat and dry air don't damage the barrel. Alcohol saved the day, like it does.

For any classic cocktails, our server will be happy to oblige.

Wine by the glass

Narendraji loved order yet eschewed routine. He would take his meals at the same time but rarely with the same cup. This is why we have an array of wines by-the-glass.

White

SULA SAUVIGNON BLANC, INDIA

Zesty and herbaceous, Sula's Sauvignon Blanc is Nashik's cool-climate whisper — think gooseberry, lemongrass and green pepper. It's India's crisp reply to New Zealand's aromatic swagger.

DOM PERIGNON XXXX, FRANCE

The monk who pioneered champagne never tasted this. Silky, smoky and serenely complex, it's the bottle that graced royal weddings and rockstar dressing rooms alike.

Bollinger's muscular elegance includes toasted hazelnuts, baked apples and spice. James Bond's champagne of choice, it's aged like a Burgundy, built like a secret agent: bold, refined, unforgettable

A classic from Alsace's most storied family this white is precise and mineral-driven with notes of citrus zest, green apple and a steely freshness that speaks clearly of place and heritage.

WENTE VINEYARDS 'MORNING FOG' CHARDONNAY, CALIFORNIA, USA

Named for the cooling coastal mist that rolls into Livermore Valley, this Chardonnay blends crisp apple and creamy oak. It's California sunshine wrapped in a blanket of morning fog.

MICHEL CHAPOUTIER 'MARIUS' VERMENTINO BLANC, FRANCE

Named for Chapoutier's great-grandfather, a man of wit and wine, this Vermentino sings with citrus, sea breeze and fennel. It's Provence in a glass — humble, honest and poetic.

COSECHA CHARDONNAY, CHILE

From Chile's sunlit valleys, Cosecha's Chardonnay blends tropical fruit with a creamy whisper of vanilla. It's the kind of wine that pairs with both ceviche and ambition.

A second wine with first-growth finesse, this red hails from Margaux's storied terroir, offering cassis, graphite and a whisper of violet. It's supple yet structured, Bordeaux elegance with a youthful charm. Decant it, and let the Left Bank speak.

J. LOHR 'PURE PASO' RED BLEND, CALIFORNIA, USA

A bold Paso Robles statement, this marries Cabernet Sauvignon's structure with Petite Sirah's intensity. Expect blackberry, espresso and a touch of vanilla oak. It's California swagger in a glass: rich, ripe and unapologetically Paso.

E. GUIGAL, CHÂTEAUNEUF-DU-PAPE, FRANCE

Mature plum, hazelnut and spiced red fruit unfold through a rich, full-bodied frame with round tannins and layered complexity. There's a whisper of tobacco, orange peel acidity and cocoa bean on the finish like a fireside conversation wrapped in velvet. Châteauneuf-du-Pape, with gravitas and gourmand charm.

FRANÇOIS LABET 'ÎLE DE BEAUTÉ' PINOT NOIR, FRANCE

From the sunlit shores of Corsica, François Labet's 'Île de Beauté' Pinot Noir is a Mediterranean take on Burgundy's noble grape. Expect wild strawberry, thyme and a whisper of sea breeze. It's island elegance: light, lyrical, and quietly captivating.

MICHEL CHAPOUTIER 'LES MEYSONNIERS' CROZES-HERMITAGE, FRANCE

From the stony slopes of Crozes-Hermitage, 'Les Meysonniers' is Chapoutier's organic ode to Syrah — black olive, violet and cracked pepper wrapped in silky tannins. It's northern Rhône finesse with southern soul, aged in wisdom and granite.

WENTE VINEYARDS 'SOUTHERN HILLS' CABERNET SAUVIGNON, CALIFORNIA

From the rolling hills of Livermore Valley, Wente's 'Southern Hills' Cabernet Sauvignon is a California classic with black cherry, cocoa and toasted oak wrapped in supple tannins. It's sunshine and structure, crafted by one of America's oldest winemaking families.

JACKY MARTEAU GAMAY, TOURAINE, FRANCE

A Loire Valley gem with a playful pulse, Jacky Marteau's Gamay from Touraine is all red currant, crushed violets and silky charm. It's Beaujolais spirit with a Loire accent: fresh, flirtatious and made for chilling.

KILLIBINBIN SNEAKY SHIRAZ, AUSTRALIA
